This is the minimum info we need to set up b2evolution on this server:

Database you want to install into

b2evolution stores blog posts, comments, user permissions, etc. in a MySQL database. You must create this database prior to instal

MySQL Host/Server:
 Typically looks like "localhost" or "sql-6" or "sql-8.yourhost.net"...

MySQL Database:
 Name of the MySQL database you have created on the server

MySQL Username:
 Used by b2evolution to access the MySQL database

MySQL Password:
 Used by b2evolution to access the MySQL database

Additional settings

Base URL:
 This is where b2evo and your blogs reside by default. CHECK THIS C.
NOT use your machine's name!

 This is used to create your admin account. You will receive notifications :
